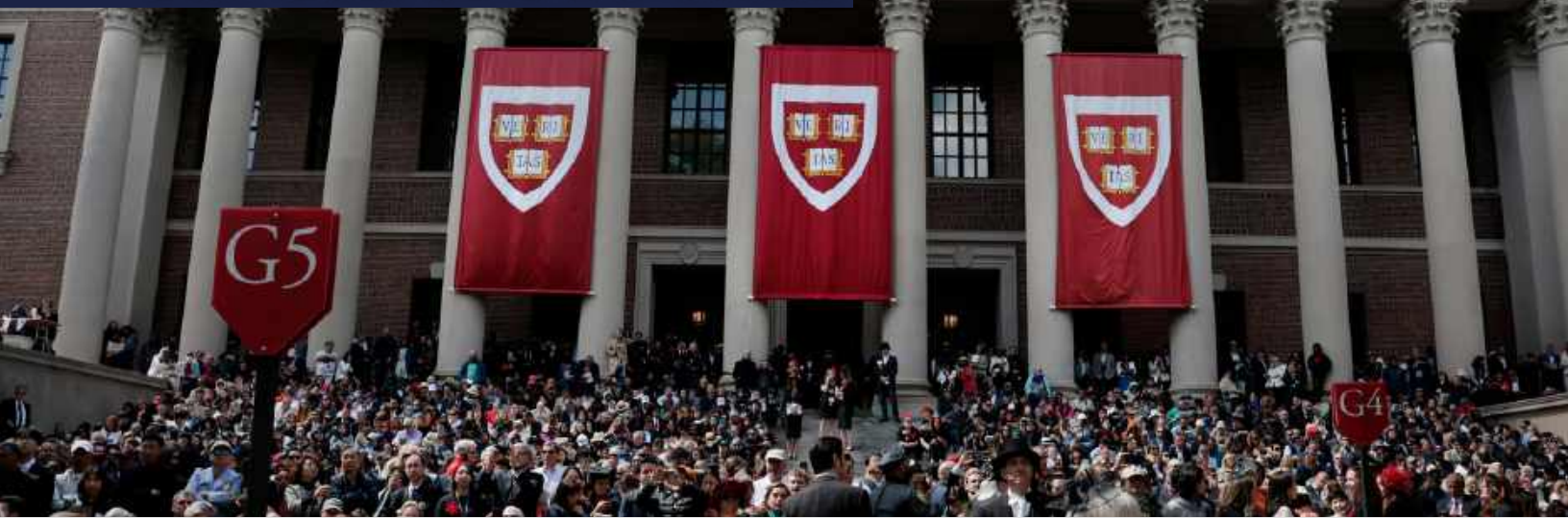

London Institute of Skills Development is the managing partner of The Oxford Club U.K, has significantly contributed to environmental sustainability by promoting the creation and conservation of **Miyawaki forests**, a method of afforestation that supports the restoration of natural ecosystems. The Miyawaki technique, developed by Japanese botanist **Akira Miyawaki**, involves planting a wide variety of native species in a small area to quickly regenerate forests. This method has been adopted by various sustainability campaigns, including "Go Green Globe," to make a profound environmental impact. Some of the key contributions of this campaign through Miyawaki forests include:

Biodiversity Restoration

Miyawaki forests are known for their high biodiversity, as they consist of native plants and trees that provide habitats for a range of local wildlife. The Go Green Globe campaign's promotion of these forests helps restore ecosystem that have been lost d-

ue to urbanization, deforestation, and industrialization.

Carbon Sequestration

The creation of Miyawaki forests contributes to carbon sequestration. These forests absorb carbon dioxide from the atmosphere, helping to mitigate climate change. Since Miyawaki forests grow rapidly and with dense vegetation, they can absorb more CO₂ in a shorter time compared to traditional plantation methods.

Soil and Water Conservation

The dense planting structure of Miyawaki forests improves soil fertility, prevents erosion, and helps retain moisture. This leads to better soil health, which in turn supports agriculture and reduces the risk of floods and droughts in the surrounding areas.

Improved Air Quality

Planting native trees and plants through the Miyawaki method improves air quality by absorbing pollutants and releasing oxygen.

This is particularly beneficial in urban areas, where air pollution is often high.

Urban Green Spaces

Through the Go Green Globe campaign, urban areas have seen the transformation of concrete jungles into green spaces. Miyawaki forests offer a solution to improve urban biodiversity and quality of life, making cities more resilient to climate change while enhancing the aesthetic and recreational value of urban landscapes.

Reduction in Urban Heat Island Effect

In cities, the urban heat island effect is a common issue where the temperatures are significantly higher than in surrounding rural areas. Miyawaki forests, with their dense canopy, help reduce temperatures by providing shade and promoting cooling, benefiting the local climate

The Go Green Globe campaign, through Miyawaki forests, aligns with the principles of sustainable development by fostering long-term environmental health, economic resilience, and social well-being.

This approach helps communities reduce their dependence on harmful environmental practices and adopt more sustainable living habits.



The Go Green Globe campaign's implementation of Miyawaki forests has proven to be a powerful tool in enhancing environmental sustainability. The first Miyawaki forest project by LISD has been completed in Kenya. However the second project at Lady Aitchison College in Lahore Pakistan has been recently wrapped up.

LISD along with TOC, is also working to develop awareness on ESG at various locations both locally and internationally. We are open to join hands with organisations in this cause to serve humanity.
